BCP 224

The Word of God

THE First Reading: 1 John 3:1-7

See what love the Father has given us, that we should be called children of God; and that is what we are. The reason the world does not know us is that it did not know him. Beloved, we are God's children now; what we will be has not yet been revealed. What we do know is this: when he is revealed, we will be like him, for we will see him as he is. And all who have this hope in him purify themselves, just as he is pure.

Everyone who commits sin is guilty of lawlessness; sin is lawlessness. You know that he was revealed to take away sins, and in him there is no sin. No one who abides in him sins; no one who sins has either seen him or known him. Little children, let no one deceive you. Everyone who does what is right is righteous, just as he is righteous.

Reader Hear what the Spirit is saying to God's people.*People* Thanks be to God.

PSALM 4 (Spoken in unison)

Answer me when I call, O God, defender of my cause; *

THE GOSPEL: Luke 24: 36b-48

Jesus himself stood among the disciples and said to them, "Peace be with you." They were startled and terrified, and thought that they were seeing a ghost. He said to them, "Why are you frightened, and why do doubts arise in your hearts? Look at my hands and my feet; see that it is I myself. Touch me and see; for a ghost does not have flesh and bones as you see that I have." And when he had said this, he showed them his hands and his feet. While in their joy they were disbelieving and still wondering, he said to them, "Have you anything here to eat?" They gave him a piece of broiled fish, and he took it and ate in their presence.

Then he said to them, "These are my words that I spoke to you while I was still with you—that everything written about me in the law of Moses, the prophets, and the psalms must be fulfilled." Then he opened their minds to understand the scriptures, and he said to them, "Thus it is written, that the Messiah is to suffer and to rise from the dead on the third day, and that repentance and forgiveness of sins is to be proclaimed in his name to all nations, beginning from Jerusalem. You are witnesses of these things.

Presentation and Examination of the Candidates

Celebrant The Candidate for Holy Baptism will now be presented.

Parents and Godparents I present N. to receive the Sacrament of Baptism.

Celebrant Will you be responsible for seeing that the child you present is brought up in the Christian faith and life? Parents and Godparents I will, with God's help.

Celebrant Will you by your prayers and witness help this child to grow into the full stature of Christ?

Parents and Godparents I will, with God's help. Then the Celebrant asks the following questions of the candidates who can speak for themselves, and of the parents and godparents who speak on behalf of the infants and younger children

Question	Do you renounce Satan and all the spiritual forces of wickedness that rebel against God?	
Answer	I renounce them.	
Question	Do you renounce the evil powers of this world which corrupt and destroy the creatures of God?	
Answer	I renounce them.	
Question Answer	Do you renounce all sinful desires that draw you from the love of God? I renounce them.	
Question Answer	Do you turn to Jesus Christ and accept Him as your Savior? I do.	
Question Answer	Do you put your whole trust in His grace and love? I do.	
Question Answer	Do you promise to follow and obey Him as your Lord? I do.	
Celebrant	Will you who witness these vows do all in your power to support these persons in their life in Christ?	
People	We will.	
Celebrant	Let us join with those who are committing themselves to Christ and renew our own baptismal covenant.	
The Baptismal Covenant		
<i>Celebrant</i> People	Do you believe in God the Father? I believe in God, the Father the almighty, creator of heaven and earth.	
Celebrant	Do you believe in Jesus Christ, the Son of God?

We thank you, Father, for the water of Baptism. In it we are buried with Christ in His death. By it, we share in His resurrection. Through it we are reborn by the Holy Spirit. Therefore in joyful obedience to your Son, we bring into His fellowship those who come to Him in faith, baptizing them in the Name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.
