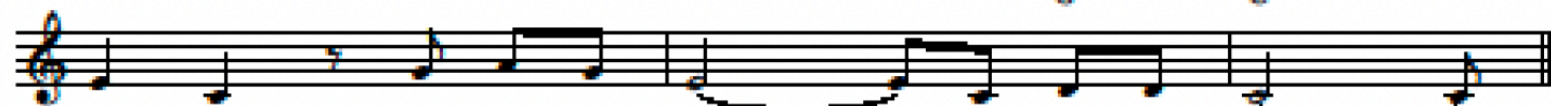

be honor and glory, now and for ever. Amen.



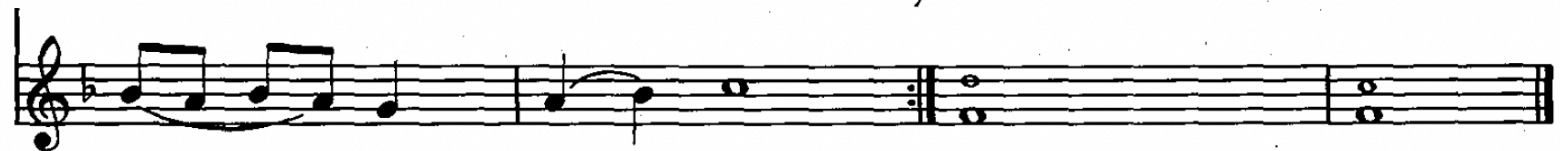
