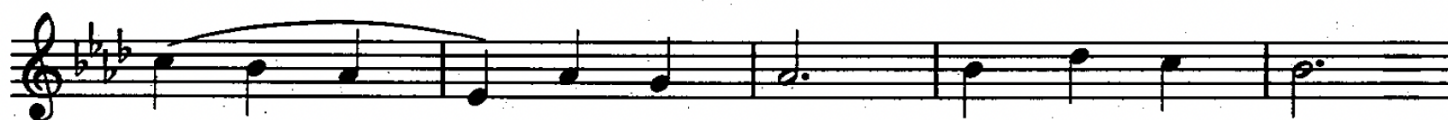
Eternal God, heavenly Father,
